1. This is an invitational event. All three nights will be live on FloRacing.com. The limited field of competitors is based on the number of haulers which can be parked in the infield using social distancing guidelines.
2. Each team is limited to the driver and four additional team members.
3. All forms and payments must be completed in advance and online.
4. Local health officials are considering professional race teams who travel together a “family unit” and have granted permission for teams within the same ‘cohort’ to stay overnight in their haulers.
5. A cloth face covering is mandatory for everyone on the grounds at Eldora Speedway.
6. Everyone must practice social distancing and follow CDC recommendations for proper hygiene like frequent hand washing and sanitizing.
7. Everyone will have their temperature checked and a medical screen conducted at 1) hauler staging on Thursday, when they attempt to re-enter the facility after leaving the grounds; and daily at their haulers in the infield.
8. ★ There will be no spectators, no camping, no suites, no concessions or food service at this event.

Any deviation of these rules and regulations may result in fines or penalties including disqualification from the event.

EVERY LAP MATTERS™ FORMAT: When competitors are on track Thursday and Friday at the Dirt Late Model Stream Invitational, they will be scoring points using Eldora's Every Lap Matters™ Format to seed Saturday night's Heat Race lineups. There are two provisional starting positions in the 67-lap Championship based on preliminary night points.

Multi-Car Qualifying: fastest 10 qualifiers -1) 50; 2) 45; 3) 42; 4) 39; 5) 37; 6) 35; 7) 33; 8) 32; 9) 31; 10) 30.

Heat Races: 1) 200; 2) 197; 3) 194; 4) 192; 5) 190; 6) 188; 7) 186; 8) 184; 9) 182; 10) 180; etc.

Feature: 1) 500; 2) 496; 3) 492; 4) 488; 5) 484; 6) 480; 7) 476; 8) 472; 9) 468; 10) 464; etc.

The original green flag must be taken on the track to score points in any Time Trial, Heat Race, B-Feature or A-Feature contest. Drivers not making a qualification attempt, late to qualifying, and/or not starting any scheduled race will score ZERO points for that particular event in the program. *A three position/one group grace MAY be granted during time trials at the discretion of the Officials, however, drivers missing their drawn position/group cannot start better than the inverted cars in their next Heat Race regardless of their best-timed lap.*

Car owners must hold an Eldora membership if winnings are payable to someone other than the driver. All Eldora members are eligible for up to \$500,000 in excess medical coverage at Eldora events.

TIRE & WHEEL RULE FOR DIRT LATE MODEL STREAM INVITATIONAL: The Hoosier LM 20 is required on the Left Front (LF), Right Front (RF) and Left Rear (LR) positions. The Hoosier LM 20 and LM 40 compounds are permitted on the Right Rear (RR) position. Tires may be buffed, cut/siped, grooved, sanded, etc. Tire rule, including alteration of factory compound from manufacturer, will be enforced according to DIRTcar rulebook. **Approved wheel covers permitted on all four corners.**

1. Minimum age for competitors is 16 years of age as of June 4, 2020. Only persons 14 years of age or older will be admitted to pit area. Minors 14, 15, 16 or 17 years of age must submit a Parental Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement/Minor's Assumption of Risk and Release and Waiver of Liability signed by BOTH of their parents (or legal guardians). No exceptions. [Click Here for Minor Waivers](#). See driver registration site for "MVP Driver/Owner Minor Vest Program." Pit rules enforced.
2. One entry per driver. Cars will be sealed at Inspection & Registration. Backup cars will only be permitted if the driver's primary car/engine/drivetrain is deemed beyond repair in the sole discretion of Eldora & DIRTcar UMP officials. Backup cars are penalized to the tail of the next subsequent race (Heat Race, B-Feature or Feature event) for which the driver has qualified. The driver's event points are retained. When use of a backup car is granted, the primary car is officially withdrawn and cannot be used again throughout the remainder of the weekend. All cars will be subject to Eldora/DIRTcar control from the time they enter the pit area until officially released after the event.
3. Only tow vehicles will be allowed inside pit area. One work area vehicle (ATV, side-by-side or similar - no sport or trail-style vehicles), per entry, may be presented for credentialing at Registration - NO RIDERS PERMITTED UNLESS SEAT EXISTS - work area vehicles must remain in pit area, may be used only at specified times and may not be used on unrestricted areas of property. Please cooperate with these rules so that we may continue to offer this courtesy.
4. ~~All drivers are required to participate in "Meet & Greet" autograph sessions.~~
5. It is strongly encouraged that the driver's last name be clearly displayed in BOLD BLOCK LETTERS on both doors and across front of roof.
6. A Racing Electronics Shift, Solo or "raceceiver-style" one-way radio (listening only to 454.000) and an **AMB/MyLaps** scoring transponder is mandatory for ALL on-track activity. You may use your own **AMB/MyLaps** scoring transponder.
7. All races will start and restart double-file in their entirety EIRI. The Start/Restart Zone and procedures will be detailed at driver meeting. All green flags must be taken on-track at the start/finish line.
8. All prize money will be mailed from Eldora to designee. Checks will not be issued without a verified IRS Form W-9 (or W-8BEN for Canadian entrants) on file. All entrants are participating on their own behalf and are completely independent of the event promoter. As an independent contractor, entrants are responsible for prize money received including all income and withholding taxes that apply to such winnings.

THURSDAY & FRIDAY PROGRAMS

MULTI-CAR QUALIFYING - Each night, multi-car qualifying using flights determined by the random electronic draw, will be used to determine Heat Race lineups in staggered fashion. A driver's fastest time from Thursday and Friday will be used as a tiebreaker, if necessary, for Saturday's lineups. If weather interrupts multi-car qualifying, the Group's Heat Race lineups will be determined by Timed Hot Laps.

HEAT RACES - The preliminary show format plans for four Heat Races of 10 laps in distance. The inversion procedure will be detailed at the Driver Meeting. Cars finishing 1st through 4th advance into the A-Feature and the balance of the finishers will advance into one of two B-Features.

B-FEATURES (\$6,000 posted) - Each night, two B-Features of 12 laps in distance will be contested. Assuming two B-Features, cars finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd will advance to the A-Feature. All other starters will receive \$125.

A-FEATURES (\$74,400 posted) - Each preliminary night will run one A-Feature of 30-laps in distance, starting 24 cars. The first four cars advance from each of the four Heat Races with the top-two finishers getting their qualifying times back. Starting positions 1 through 6 will be inverted slowest to fastest based on qualifying times, followed by the seventh and eighth fastest times from the top-two in their Heat Races, and starting positions nine through 16 will be lined up by Heat Race finish: 9th H-1.3, 10th H-2.3, 11th H-3.3, 12th H-4.3, 13th H-1.4, 14th H-2.4, 15th H-3.4, 16th H-4.4. The two fastest qualifiers who do not advance from the Heat Races will start 17th and 18th. Starting positions 19, 21 and 23 will come from B-Feature #1 and positions 20, 22 and 24 will come from B-Feature #2. Prize money will be distributed to finishing positions as follows: 1) \$10,000; 2) 4,000; 3) 2,700; 4) 2,250; 5) 2,000; 6) 1,600; 7) 1,400; 8) 1,300; 9) 1,200; 10) 1,000; 11) 950; 12) 900; 13) 800; 14) 750; 15) 700; 16) 675; 17) 660; 18) 650; 19) 640; 20) 625; 21) 600; 22) 600; 23) 600; and 24) 600.

SATURDAY

HEAT RACES - There will be four Heat Races of 15 laps in distance. Pre-invert lineups established via the "Every Lap Matters™ Format" in staggered order (tiebreakers: 1) best finish from Thursday and Friday; 2) fastest time; 3) ONLINE entry received by June 1). The inversion, up to six cars, will be determined randomly. Cars finishing 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in the Heat Races advance to the Invitational Championship. Cars finishing 5th-12th advance to a B-Feature, in order of finishing position. Heats 1 and 2 will determine B-Feature #1 and Heats 3 and 4 will determine B-Feature #2.

PROVISIONALS (TWO) - The two drivers highest in the "Every Lap Matters™ Format" who do not advance from the Heat Races will start 17th and 18th in the Dirt Late Model Stream Invitational (if qualified for a B-Feature, Heat Race results are adjusted).

B-FEATURES (\$4,800 posted) - There will be two B-Features of 15 laps in distance. Cars finishing 1st through 3rd advance to the Dirt Late Model Stream Invitational. The finish of the B-Features determines alternate starters for the 67-lap Invitational Championship. Prize money will be distributed to those drivers not advancing as follows: \$200 each.

INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP (\$119,875 posted) - The Invitational Championship will be 67 green flag laps in distance starting 24 cars.
